- 3. All three passages above encourage us to be always thankful in all circumstances: "always giving thanks to God the Father for everything" (Eph. 5:20); "whatever you do, ...do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God" (Col. 3:17); "give thanks in all circumstances" (1 Thess. 5:18).
 - What are some ways/habits/practices that have helped you in the past to develop a thankful heart in spite of your circumstances?

"God says to give thanks in everything. That doesn't mean you need to give thanks FOR everything... You are not to give thanks FOR the difficulties, but rather IN the difficulties...
